- the other authors' (if any) given and family names and their addresses.

Acceptance will be confirmed by December 31, 2006. Information on the format of the papers and the deadline for their submission will be published in the Second Announcement.

CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS AND LANGUAGE

Papers should be written in English; however, they can be presented either in English or in Polish. Simultaneous interpretation from Polish into English and from English in to Polish will be available. All papers will be published in conference proceedings (on a CD). Papers will also be published in the INTERNATIONAL JOURNAL OF OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND ERGONOMICS (JOSE), which is now covered by the Social Sciences Index of Thomson Scientific (formerly ISI), or in ARCHIVES OF ACOUSTICS, after they have been accepted for publication by the respective editorial boards of those scientific journals.

EXHIBITION

ELBLAG AND ITS ENVIRONS




Elblag, founded in 1237 by the Teutonic Knights, is a dynamic city and an industrial, academic and cultural centre. Elblag's Old Town with its historic urban plan, homesteads lying at the foot of the castle and a complex of reconstructed tenement houses is one of the largest areas in Europe covered by a comprehensive archaeological

Of special interest are:

- 13th century cathedral church of St. Nicholas, with its late Gothic triptychs and Gothic wooden figures of the Apostles,
- fragments of 14th century city walls with a city gate (Brama Targowa),
- 13th century, formerly Dominican, church of the Virgin Mary.

Elblag is lucky to be close to numerous tourist attractions; a visit to Frombork and a cruise on the Kanał Ostródzko-Elblaski (the Ostróda-Elblag Canal) are not to be missed, to mention just two. The Kanał Ostródzko-Elblaski is a spectacular, world-class, historic monument. The difference (of up to 100 m) in the water levels of the lakes the canal connects is overcome with a set of slipways designed in the 19th century. That technical solution means part of the cruise takes place on grass.



Frombork is almost 700 years old. The city has unique monuments and mementos related to the activity of Nicolaus Copernicus, the world-famous astronomer, physician and Doctor of Canon Law. He conducted astronomical observations and wrote his main work "De revolutionibus orbium coelestium" in Frombork,
